"The Caloosahatchee River: As It Was"

Mr. Joseph H. Thomas, president of the LaBelle Heritage museum will be presenting a program "The Caloosahatchee River: As It Was". A presentation of photographs of the Caloosahatchee River (1885-1960) accompanying a talk on the river before its channelization and the change from a shallow, meandering stream with its headwaters at Lake Hickpochee to the western leg of the cross state Okeechobee Waterway. We will see how the Caloosahatchee River was before its current existence as the Caloosahatchee River Ship Canal C-43, a part of the Okeechobee Waterway. The floor will be open to questions after the presentation. The program will be presented December 7th, 7:00 p.m. in the Club House.

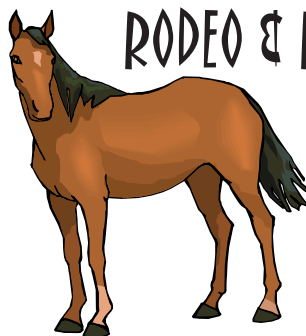

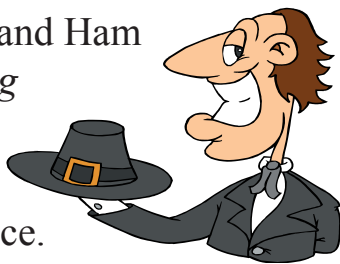
