

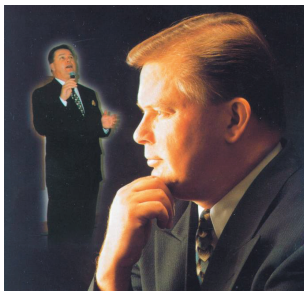

KARAOKE

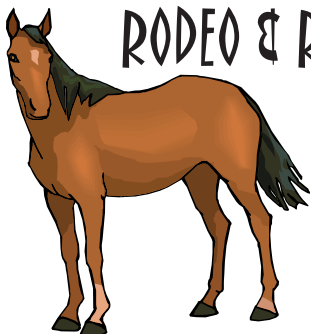
Our next Karoke Night will be Tuesday, March 2nd. We are encouraging everyone to select a song to share with your friends. Please peruse the

UPDATE FROM KEITH & PEG

The heart monitor was returned after the 30 days of monitoring. They got a letter from the cardiac doctor (yes, a letter, not a follow up visit) which said that his heart is functioning as it should and it is not the cause of the symptoms. Great, now we wait to see what blood work is needed and wait more to get the results. The pediatrician is testing among many things for thyroid problems as his symptoms could be caused by either hypo or hyper thyroid.

There is still the issue of his asthma flaring up and a hospital trip being necessary because the asthma treatment also speeds up the heart rate.

So we wait and continue to pray. Thanks to all of you for your prayers. We are thankful that his heart is not the problem, but we still need prayers for the cause and treatment to fix whatever it is. -Peg
