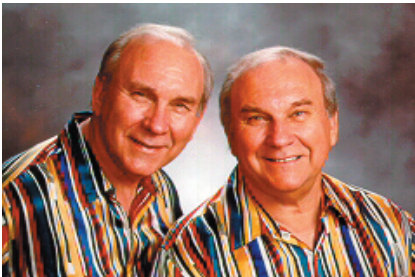

"The Good Twins" from Branson, Missouri



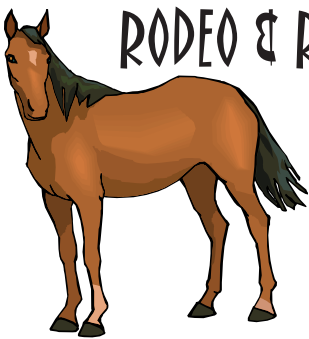
The Good Twins, Dwight and Dwayne, started singing at age 3 -- more than 60 years ago. And they haven't stopped doing concerts and recording Christian music. They have traveled over 3 million miles with performances in over 8,000 concerts and revivals in 24 different countries.

Some 33 albums (records, tapes and CDs) have now been released by the Good Twins. In 1961 they made musical history as the first to use pre-recorded background tapes at concerts -- a novel method that has since become very common.

Not satisfied with piano/organ backup, their albums are orchestrated by such well-known Christian arranger /conductors as Jimmy Owens, Ralph Carmichael and Stan Endicott.

A 1968 album, Church Is Finally Over, won a NEFF* award for best duet album of the year.

The Good Twins have had a special ministry to Russia since 1992. Dwight has been to Russia 29 times and is vice-president of ChildLife International (CLI). CLI brings Russian children to America who need critical life-saving operations that can't be performed in Russia.

The 28th annual farm tour in Hendry County is slated for Saturday February 6, 2010.

The event is hosted by The Hendry County Farm-City Tour Council. Tickets are \$60 per person and the participants will be able to catch a modern air-conditioned tour bus at the Hendry County Extension Office in LaBelle.

Hendry County is one of the largest agricultural counties in the state. It is one of the largest orange producers in Florida with more than 75,000 acres of groves. In the state, it's also the second largest producer of sugarcane and third largest producer of vegetables. It's the fifth largest in beef cattle.

This year's tour will include visits to vegetable transplant and ornamental nurseries, citrus, sod, sugarcane and vegetable fields, and one of the largest beef cattle ranches in the state. There will be fresh Florida orange juice breaks along the way and a steak lunch with all the trimmings served by the Hendry County Cattlemen's Association in a rural, county setting.
