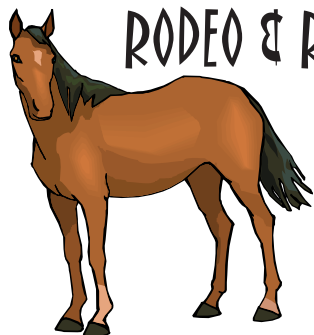
### LET'S DANCE BABY!
