## IMPORTANT STORAGE INFORMATION

This year we will be restructuring our storage areas. The storage area near the Exercise Room will be eliminated. There will also be no storage in the Clubhouse Parking Lot. All storage will be confined to the storage area west of the canal near the Maintenance Building. There is a nice smooth lot and in the future there will be a fence around the lot.

If you have anything in the storage area by the Exercise Room or in the Clubhouse Parking Lot, it will need to be moved before you leave or no later than May 1st.

Everything left in storage will cost \$2.00 per foot per month. This means if you have a trailer that is 20 feet long, it will cost \$40.00 per month to store it. Anything left in storage must have a tag that shows it is registered in the Resort Office.

Anything that is not moved and tagged by May 1st will be moved by maintenance staff and the process of obtaining title will begin. Please help us identify your equipment and get it moved to the proper place.

Those who have an annual lot rental are still allowed to store rigs, boats, sheds, etc., on their site. Please contact the office for questions and concerns. Thank you for your help.
